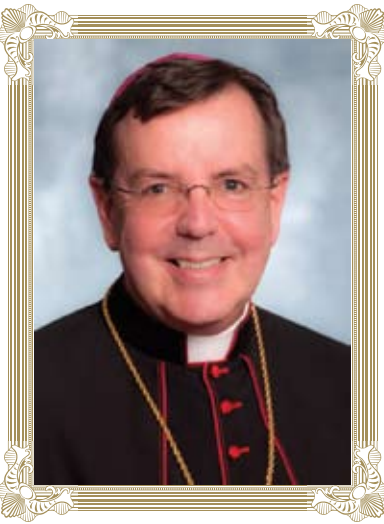

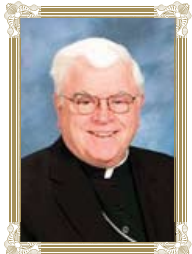

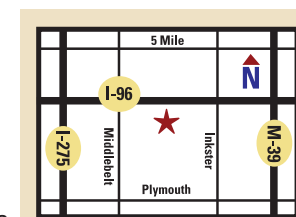
Catechist Enrichment Credits

Keynote Speaker at Saturday Dinner & Sunday Afternoon at the DIA



Johnette Benkovic is Founder and President of Living His Life Abundantly® International, Inc., a Catholic evangelization apostolate with outreaches in television, radio, print, and internet communications. She is also founder of Women of Grace®, a Catholic apostolate for women. After years of being a non-practicing Catholic, Johnette experienced a deep conversion back to her Catholic faith in 1981 and discerned a call to share the Gospel message through the media. Johnette is Executive Producer of *The Abundant Life* (seen on EWTN), a television

program that discusses contemporary issues from a Catholic perspective. She is also host of *Women of Grace Live*, a one hour call-in radio talk show heard locally on WDEO-990 AM that airs live five times a week. Johnette will speak at the Saturday evening dinner on *Call To Fidelity, The Power of Truth*. On Sunday a maximum of 200 people can register to hear her speak at the Detroit Institute of Arts on *Communicating Truth in the Culture of Our Day*. Register early to assure your place!



Fr. Edmund McCaffrey, O.S.B., Ph.D., President of Eternal Life is the former Abbot Ordinary of Belmont Abbey, Charlotte, N.C. He is a political scientist, a scholar, writer, lecturer, retreat master, educator, defender of the faith, a strong proponent of Marian devotion and extraordinary defender of the sacredness of human life. Father is a Spiritual Director of Eternal Life which he cofounded with Fr. John Hardon and William Smith.

His talk is titled *No Peace in the World and Church without Mary: Heed the Message of Fatima*.



Al Kresta is a broadcaster, journalist, and author who is, first of all, a missionary. He is President and CEO of Ave Maria Communication and the host of *Kresta in the Afternoon* heard on WDEO 990 AM. He became well known in the Detroit area for his program, *Talk from the Heart*, one of the top-rated Christian talk shows during the 1980's and 90's. When he began the program, Al was a Protestant pastor. The questions forced upon him as pastor, however, led him to return to the Catholic Church. His profound personal conversion to Christ and return to the Catholic Church is told in the best-selling anthology *Surprised by Truth*. He will use his journalistic skills to expose *The American Catholic Council in 4D: Dissent, Division and the Devil in the Details*.

Saturday Conference Speakers



Jeff Cavins, M.A. our Master of Ceremonies, earned his M.A. in Theology from Franciscan University of Steubenville. He is the founding host of EWTN's *Life on the Rock* and Relevant Radio's *Morning Air*. He is the author of several books, including *My Life on the Rock: A Rebel Returns to the Catholic Faith* and *I'm Not Being Fed: The Food That Satisfies the Soul*. He created *The Great Adventure Bible Study* series. His talk is titled: *Mind Your King's Business*. Whether it be TV, the Internet, the arts or sports, there is someone or something that will land on the throne of your heart. In this talk, Jeff discusses the struggles and joys of allowing Jesus, Who is the Truth, to be Lord and King in our lives, rather than "doing it my way."



Fr. Clement Machado, S.O.L.T was born and raised in Canada. He served as Parochial Vicar in Montreal and as Parochial Administrator in Ottawa. Fr. Machado now works with Vatican Radio in Rome and has presented a series of programs on EWTN, many dealing with spiritual warfare. He promotes healing of the whole person: body, mind, heart, and soul through intercessory prayer, sacramentals, and the sacraments. His talk is *Spiritual Warfare and New Age Illusion*.



Paul Rondeau, M.A. is an independent consultant, researcher, and writer focusing on the rhetoric, communication strategy, and tactics of radical social marketers in America. His research on the homosexual rights movement has been praised by pro-family organizations around the world as "critically important." It has been cited before the U.S. Supreme Court and the United Nations, translated into multiple languages, and referenced in best selling books. Mr. Rondeau has appeared on EWTN, CBN, AFA radio, and other media. He will present *Selling Darkness as Enlightenment: Fine Sounding Arguments and Beguiling Words*.



Raymond de Souza is Brazilian by birth, Catholic by grace, and Australian by choice. He is founder and director of the international apostolate Saint Gabriel Communications of Australia, South Africa and the United States which promotes Catholic Apologetics as a major tool for the New Evangelization. He hosts a program on EWTN, is program director for Human Life International, is chairman of the Sacred Heart Legion and is a member of the advisory board of Catholics Come Home. His presentation is titled *De-Christianization and Catholic Action of the 21st Century*.
