
A Message From Archbishop Allen Vigneron




Saturday Conference Speakers

Saturday: Continental breakfast, box lunch and snack break are included in the registration fee. Dinner is included in the Saturday Savings Package or may be purchased separately.


Sunday: Continental breakfast will be available following Mass at Assumption Grotto. The DIA cafeteria is open 11:30 am to 3 pm at participant's expense.
