Please pray for the success of the upcoming conference: for Cardinal Burke, the Call to Holiness Board and all involved with planning the Dinner, Holy Hour and Pontifical Mass.

Raymond Leo Burke was born in Richland Center, Wisconsin, on June 30, 1948. He attended high school at Holy Cross Seminary in La Crosse, Wisconsin, before attending the Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C., and the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. He was ordained to the priesthood by Pope Saint Paul VI on June 29, 1975. He is a canon lawyer and scholar.

Ordained a bishop in 1995 by Pope Saint John Paul II, he served for almost nine years as Bishop of La Crosse, where he founded the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe. On December 2, 2003, Bishop Burke was named Archbishop of Saint Louis. From 2008-2014, he served as Prefect of the Supreme Tribunal of the Apostolic Signatura in Rome. He was elevated to the College of Cardinals in 2010 by Pope Benedict XVI. In November 2014, he was named Patron of the Sovereign Military Hospitaller Order of Saint John of Jerusalem of Rhodes and of Malta.

Cardinal Burke has also served on the Congregation for Causes of Saints, the Congregation for Bishops, the Pontifical Council for Legislative Texts, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, and the Council of Cardinals and Bishops of the Section for Relations with States of the Secretariat of State. He is prefect emeritus and a member of the Supreme Tribunal of the Apostolic Signatura in Rome.

Cardinal Burke is an episcopal advisor to the Call to Holiness. In 2003, (then Bishop) Burke spoke at the CTH conference. At the request of Fr. John A. Hardon, S.J., founder of the Marian Catechist Apostolate, Cardinal Burke is the International Director of the Marian Catechist Apostolate.

Father John A. Hardon, S.J., of blessed memory, because of his strict adherence to the Holy Father's magisterium and his unceasing apostolic zeal, according to his vocation as a religious and priest, anticipated the Holy Father's appeal for the new evangelization, the new Christianization of America, by founding the Marian Catechist Apostolate or the Association of Marian Catechists and directing the association until his death in December of the Great Jubilee of the Year 2000. The foundation of the Marian Catechists was a response to the request of our Holy Father that Father Hardon organize a catechetical training program for the Missionaries of Charity of Mother Teresa of Calcutta. The program for Mother Teresa's Sisters developed into a program of spiritual and doctrinal formation for catechists in our country and far beyond.

The heart of the Marian Catechist Apostolate is to fulfill Christ's directive to proclaim the Gospel to all nations, so that in knowing God, all might love Him; that in loving Him, all might serve Him; that in serving Him, all souls might be saved. The purpose of the Marian Catechist Apostolate is:

To cultivate love of the Holy Eucharist, devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, and unswerving loyalty to the Holy Father and the Magisterium (the teaching authority) of the Catholic Church.

To prepare members to share the gift of Christ's truth and love, as found in its fullness in the teachings and practice of the Catholic Church, through the Apostolate of Catechesis.

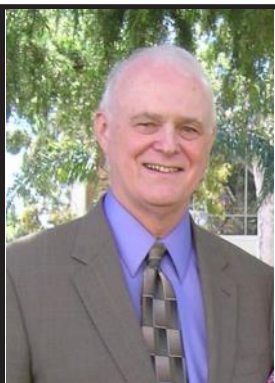
