Package includes admission to the DIA, a special exhibit private preview and presentation by a DIA art expert and an individual audio guided tour of the Rembrandt exhibit. Enjoy free time to explore other galleries of the DIA, the gift shop and the cafeteria which is open from 11am to 3pm.

Optional: Docent-led tour of Christian art in other galleries with a trained art guide. Guided tours are \$5 per person extra.

Rembrandt lived in Amsterdam in the 1600s, where Christians and Jews intermingled to a degree that was unusual in Europe at the time. Rembrandt, who is associated with the Calvinist Church, lived in a largely Jewish neighborhood. He was deeply interested in Jesus' Jewish identity and the Jewish roots of Christianity. Studying earlier images of Jesus and living in the midst of inter-religious dialogs swirling in 17th century Amsterdam, Rembrandt created groundbreaking images that profoundly changed the artistic image of Jesus in the West. Rembrandt and the Face of Jesus brings together for the first time many of Dutch master Rembrandt van Rijn's finest paintings, prints and drawings that portray Jesus and events described in the Bible. The exhibition of 60 works includes approximately 52 small, intimate paintings, prints and drawings by Rembrandt and his students that illustrate how Rembrandt broke from traditional 17th century representations of Jesus.
